

Tracked Mowers Family Brochure

Compact remote-controlled tracked mowers for orchard lanes, smaller estates, rough grass, and other mowing-led work where compact access or broader routine coverage is the main decision.

This brochure is a buyer-facing overview. Final configuration, delivery details, and field fit should be confirmed during quotation review.

Family positioning

- Use the tracked mower family when the work is still mower-led and the priority is compact tracked access, cleaner flat-blade mowing, and practical movement on maintained ground.
- GST-550 is the compact route for tighter orchard lanes, smaller estates, and projects where easier transport and access still matter most.
- GST-900 is the step-up route when the buyer still wants a tracked mower rather than a flail machine, but needs broader daily mowing coverage.

What the family is built for

- Orchard lanes and narrow-access mowing work
- Smaller estates and routine grounds maintenance
- Slope edges and difficult-access mowing where the operator should stay off the bank
- Rough-grass cutting where a flat-blade tracked mower is still the right tool

Public route notes

- Remote-control distance on public-facing material: 200 m
- Slope wording on public-facing material: up to 45° slope capability; working conditions vary by terrain, vegetation, traction, operator practice, and safety requirements
- Battery wording on public-facing material: 2 × 12V 20Ah batteries in series (24V system)
